CRM (DB) 4246 of 2024

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **483** of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita Act, 2023 (previously Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973), in connection with **Sessions Case No. 10(03)2022** arising out of R.C.C.H.G. 0562021S0003 OF 2021 dated 25.08.2021 under Sections 143/ 144/ 147/ 148/ 149/ 302/ 307/ 325/ 326/ 341/447/449/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, on the basis of **Gangnapur** Police Station Case No. **65 of 2021** dated 03.05.2021.

1. Co-accused were enlarged on bail by the coordinate Bench.
2. Claim for parity with such coaccused cannot be denied.
3. In such circumstances, we grant bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the **Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranaghat, Nadia**, subject to condition that the petitioners shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

5. In the event, the petitioners fail to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without further reference to this Court.
6. The prayer for bail of the petitioners is **allowed**.
7. CRM(DB) 4246 of 2024 is **disposed of**.
