CRM (DB) 4255 of 2024

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 corresponding to under Section **483** of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in connection with **Berhampore** Police Station Case No. **708 of 2023** dated 01.06.2023 under Sections **341/325/326/307/302/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

1. Coaccused was enlarged on bail by the coordinate Bench on January 22, 2025 passed in CRM(DB) 3278 of 2024.
2. In such circumstances, on the ground of parity, we grant bail to the petitioner.
3. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the **Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Berhampore**, subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

4. In the event, the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without further reference to this Court.
5. The prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.
6. CRM(DB) 4255 of 2024 is **disposed of**.
