1. Heard learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record including the injury report. Injury does not appear to be grievous or life threatening. Petitioner has complied with the condition imposed earlier.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner on similar terms and conditions.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner viz., **Montu Sk @ Mohabbat Sk @ Mahbbat Sk** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and on further condition petitioner while on bail shall meet the investigating officer once in a week until further orders. He shall

appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
