**CRM (DB) 4281 of 2024**

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 pertaining to Section **483** of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023, in connection with **Kaliganj** Police Station Case No. **242** of **2022** dated 22.4.2022 under Sections **148/149/341/326/307 and 302** of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3/ 4 of the Explosive Substances Act.

1. Coaccused were enlarged on bail by the coordinate Bench on September 5, 2024 passed in CRM(DB) 2222 of 2024 and on December 6, 2024 passed in CRM(DB) 3116 of 2024.
2. On the ground of parity with the other coaccused, we grant bail to the petitioner.
3. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the **Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nadia at Krishnagar**, subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and

shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

4. In the event, the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without further reference to this Court.
5. The prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.
6. CRM(DB) 4281 of 2024 is **disposed of**.
