In re: An Application for **Bail** under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/section **483** of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Goghat** Police Station Case No. **532** of **2024** dated **22.11.2024** under Sections **85/316(2)/75/103/80/61(2)** of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 read with Section **3/4** of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

The police case was registered on an order passed under Section 156(3) of the Cr.P.C.

The petition under Section 156 (3) of the Cr.P.C. was instituted three months after the incident.

Post Mortem report of the victim does not suggest homicidal death.

In such circumstances, we grant bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/-

(Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the **Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arambagh, Hooghly** subject to condition that the petitioners shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioners fail to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail of the petitioners is **allowed**.

C.R.M.(DB) 4318 of 2024 is disposed of.
