This is a contempt proceeding arising from an order dated **May 16, 2024**.

Mr. Anirban Bose, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that, the direction of this court stands complied with. However, he prays for liberty to claim interest on the delayed payment made by the authority on account of the retiral benefits of the petitioner.

Mr. Jayanta Samanta, learned Junior Government advocate appears for respondent nos. 1 and 2.

Mr. Sk. Nayeemul Haque, learned advocate appears for alleged contemnor no. 3.

Mr. Nilay Baran Mandal, learned advocate appears for alleged contemnor no. 4.

Considering the submissions as recorded above, since the direction of this Court stands complied with, nothing further survives in the contempt proceeding.

Accordingly, **CPAN 1981 of 2024** stands **dropped** and **closed**.

However, petitioner shall be at liberty to claim interest on delayed payment of retiral benefits in accordance with law.

The application being **CPAN 1981 of 2024** stands **disposed of**, without any order as to costs.
