The petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that
the complaint which was addressed to the police
authorities on 22.06.2023 was not acted upon.

State has submitted a report which reflects
that Baguiati Police Station Case No. 368/2023
dated 22.06.2023 was registered for investigation
under the relevant provisions of law and the police
authorities after collection of evidence submitted
charge-sheet before the jurisdictional court on or
about 31.07.2023. Having considered that the
police authorities have taken steps, I am of the view
that the purpose for which the writ petition was
preferred has been subserved. If there is any
grievance in respect of the charge-sheet submitted

before the jurisdictional court, it would be for the petitioner to ventilate such grievance before the court in seisin of Baguiati Police Station Case No. 368/2023 dated 22.06.2023.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition being WPA 28702 of 2023 is disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
