1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.

It appears from the submissions made on behalf of both the parties that, in compliance of the directions passed by the Court on 3rd December, 2024 in WPA 27743 of 2024, the petitioner has already approached the Debts Recovery Tribunal.
