1. The petitioner seeks renewal of his passport.
2. Learned ASGI submits, upon instructions, that the petitioner is required to make application online for renewal of passport.

4. In the event such an application is made, the same shall be considered by the authority in accordance with law at the earliest but positively within a period of four weeks from the date of filing the application.
5. The petitioner shall be obliged to comply with all the statutory formalities for renewal of the passport.
