CRM (DB) 4387 of 2024

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in connection with **Santipur** Police Station Case No. **1049** of **2024** dated **07.08.2024** under Sections **310(2)/317(3)/61(2)** of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 read with Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

1. Coaccused was enlarged on bail by the coordinate Bench on February 14, 2025.
2. Trial is in progress.
3. Considering the period of custody of the petitioner, coaccused being on bail, trial is in progress and the materials on record, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the **Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranaghat** subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and

shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

5. In the event, the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without further reference to this Court.
6. The prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.
7. CRM(DB) 4387 of 2024 is **disposed of**.
