1. The petitioners seek enlargement on bail, claiming **parity** with the co-accused who was granted bail by this Court in **CRM (NDPS) 1404 of 2025** vide order dated **18.12.2025**.

2. Learned advocate for the state candidly affirmed the prayer of the petitioner.

3. Having considered the order passed by the learned **Coordinate Bench** and noting that the present petitioners stand on the same footing as the co-accused already enlarged on bail, this Court is inclined to grant similar relief to the petitioners herein.

4. Accordingly, the application for bail is **allowed**.

5. It is directed that the petitioners be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of **Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** each, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be **local**, to the satisfaction of the learned **Additional Sessions Judge, 1st Court, Barrackpore, North 24 Parganas**.

6. The grant of bail is subject to the following conditions:

I. The petitioners shall be physically present before the learned Trial Court on **each and every date** fixed for hearing;

II. The petitioners **shall not leave the jurisdiction** of the district of North 24 Parganas without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

7. In the event the petitioners fail to comply with any of the conditions stipulated above, the learned Trial Court shall be at **liberty to cancel their bail** in accordance with law, without further reference to this Court.

8. **C.R.M. (NDPS) 1750 of 2025** is, thus, **disposed of**.
