1. Case of the petitioner is that his representation filed before the Howrah District Magistrate in December 2024 is pending consideration.
2. An opportunity of hearing shall be given to the petitioner for production of documents in support of his claim. in the writ petition are deemed not to have been admitted by the respondents.
