1. By an order dated February 12, 2025, the petitioner was granted *interim* bail on the touchstone of Article 21 of the Constitution of India.
2. The State files a report which indicates that the petitioner has been complying with the conditions of *interim* bail.
3. We further see that the trial is yet to conclude.
4. Since the petitioner has been adhering to the conditions of *interim* bail and there is no adverse report in that regard, we are inclined to confirm the order of *interim* bail that the petitioner is enjoying on the same terms and conditions on which *interim* bail was granted and we do so.
5. Accordingly, the application for bail being CRM (DB) 53 of 2025 is disposed of by confirming the *interim* bail on the same terms and conditions.
