Co-accused was granted bail by us on February 20, 2025 passed in C.R.M. (DB) 4288 of 2024.

Petitioner before us stands on a better footing than such co-accused apparently on the strength of the materials on record.

In such circumstances, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/-

(Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the **Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tehatta, Nadia** subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

C.R.M.(DB) 4417 of 2024 is disposed of.
