Co-accused was enlarged on bail by the Coordinate Bench on February 19, 2025 passed in C.R.M. (DB) 449 of 2025.

Petitioner stands on a better footing than such co-accused.

In such circumstances, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the **Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barrackpore,**

North 24-Parganas subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

C.R.M.(DB) 4416 of 2024 is disposed of.
