1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the medical papers. Victim lady is presently out of hospital.
3. Keeping in mind the facts and circumstances of the case we are of the opinion further detention of the petitioner is not necessary and he may be granted bail.
4. Accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM Siliguri on condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

5. In the event he fails to appear before the trial court without justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail automatically without reference to this court.
6. The application being CRM (DB) 34 of 2025 is disposed of.
