In Re : An Application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 filed in connection with GR Case No. 5392 of 2023 corresponding to Bhaktinagar P.S. Case No. 923/2023 dated 16.10.2023 under Sections 498A/323/325/376/506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners challenged the proceedings arising out of Bhaktinagar P.S. Case No. 923/2023 dated 16.10.2023. Learned advocate for the petitioners submits that the present petitioners happen to be the mother-in-law and sister-in-law of the *de facto* complainant/opposite party no.2.

Mr. Biswas, learned advocate appearing for the State submits that during the pendency of the revisional application, already charge-sheet has been submitted before the jurisdictional court on or about 28.07.2024. It has also been submitted on behalf of the State that charge-sheet has been submitted under Sections 498A/323/506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Having considered the fact that the petitioners approached this Court for quashing of the FIR and subsequently charge-sheet has been submitted, I am of the view that there has been change of circumstances. Consequently the petitioners would be at liberty to approach this Court after receipt of the documents under Section 207 of the Code of Criminal Procedure or after praying for discharge at the stage of consideration of charges before the learned Trial Court.

With the aforesaid observations, the revisional application being CRR 49 of 2024 is disposed of.

Pending connected application, if any, is consequently disposed of.
