It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the incident occurred on 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 and the FIR was lodged on the next date i.e. on 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2018. After conclusion of the investigation, Police submitted charge sheet on 19<sup>th</sup> March, 2021. It is further alleged that the case is pending since then before the Magistrate concerned for service of the copy of paper under Section 207 of the Cr.P.C. and for commitment. He further submits that the Court below has fixed the next date on 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2025. He further submits that there are 23 accused persons, who are required to be tried before the regular Court out of which some of the accused persons remain absent on each and every

date and for which the Court below could neither serve copy to the accused persons nor committed the case before the Sessions Court and the proceeding is delayed day by day.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the State submits that if any direction is passed upon the Court below securing attendance of the accused persons on the next date of hearing, the State will serve copy to the accused persons and the case may be committed before the Sessions Court.

Having heard learned Counsel appearing on behalf of both the parties and considering the fact that the prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is innocuous and is required to be allowed for the ends of justice, C.R.R. 96 of 2025 is hereby disposed of with a direction upon the Court below to make necessary direction for securing attendance of all the accused persons on the next date of hearing i.e. on 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2025 and he is further directed to make every endeavour for service of copy and to take next course of action, preferably within a period of sixty days from the next date.
