1. Report has been filed by the SJDA mentioning that the petitioners would be entitled to get flat as per the rehabilitation package policy. A flat has already been allotted to the petitioners.

2. The matter has been referred by SJDA to UDMA Department for instruction and approval.

3. Learned advocate representing UDMA Department submits that no permission and/or approval was obtained by SJDA prior to allotment of flat to the petitioners.

4. As SJDA asserts that the file is pending approval before UDMA, accordingly, the instant writ petition stands disposed of by directing the Principal Secretary, UDMA to take a decision on the request made by SJDA regarding approval/instruction for allotment of flat to the petitioners.

5. An opportunity of hearing shall be granted by UDMA Department to the petitioners and representative of SJDA.

6. A decision in the matter shall be taken at the earliest but positively within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of this order.

7. A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to all the parties immediately thereafter.

8. The Principal Secretary shall keep in mind that the issue relates to the year 2007 and a final decision shall positively be taken within the time limit specified hereinabove.

9. The writ petition stands disposed of.

10. Urgent photostat certified copy of this order, if applied for, be given to the parties, upon compliance of necessary formalities.
