Affidavit-of-service filed by the learned advocate for the petitioners be kept with the record.

The husband of the petitioner was an approved Panchayat Karmee, who died-in-harness on January 09, 2006.

The first Pension Payment Order of the employee concerned was issued on May 06, 2014.

Under the ROPA Rules, 2009, there was revision of the pension, gratuity and computation of pension of the pensioners vide Memorandum of the Government of West Bengal bearing No. 73/SE(B)/JM-4/2009 dated May 19, 2009 and the revised pension payment order of the employee concerned under ROPA, 2009 was issued on January 10, 2024, in terms of the said revised pension payment order, the petitioner received the arrear amount pension and gratuity was disbursed on January 24, 2024.

The petitioner in the instant writ petition is claiming that she is entitled to interest for the

delayed payment of the said gratuity and arrear pension and is praying issuance of writ of mandamus commanding the Director of Pension, Provident Fund and Group Insurance and the concerned Treasury Officer, the respondents herein, to pay such interest.

Learned advocate for the State-respondents does not oppose the prayer of the petitioner.

It is now well settled that the petitioner is entitled to the interest, as prayed for.

The aforementioned respondents are, therefore directed to pay interest on the revised gratuity and arrear family pension @ 8% per annum from the date of notification of the aforesaid Government order i.e. May 19, 2009 till the date of payment of revised gratuity and arrear family pension in terms of the said revised Pension payment order.

The payment, as aforesaid, shall be made within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of this order, in default, the said arrears amount shall fetch an additional interest of 2% per annum.

W.P.A 1099 of 2025 stands disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
