The petitioner seeks parity with co accused Biplab Biswas who has been granted bail by this Court earlier.

Learned counsel for the State does not oppose the said fact.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is similarly circumstanced with the co accused who has been granted bail earlier, he deserves the same benefit.

Accordingly, prayer for bail is allowed.

The petitioner namely **Sukumar Mandal** be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalpaiguri subject to condition that he shall not leave the jurisdiction of the districts of

Jalpaiguri and Cooch Behar without prior permission of the learned trial Judge till completion of trial. He shall appear before the learned trial Court on every date of hearing fixed by the learned trial Court and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to adhere to any of the conditions as stated above without justifiable cause, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is thus disposed of.
