Heard learned counsels for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no nexus with the alleged offence.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer.

I have considered the material on record. Contraband articles were recovered from a vehicle parked in front of the petitioner's house. The petitioner is not the owner of the vehicle.

Considering the extent of complicity of the petitioner in the alleged offence, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner **Majibul Islam** be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to provision under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. The petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within two weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
