In view of the above, this Court is inclined to hold that the petitioners are able to rebut the statutory restriction

under Section 37 of the NDPS Act and are entitled to anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioners **(1) Jalil Sekh @ Jalil Miah** and **(2) Azizul Sekh @ Ajijul Hoque** be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to provision under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. The petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within two weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
