C.R.M. (A) 477 of 2025

I have considered the material on record. There is no allegation of assault either in the written complaint or in the material available on record. Investigation has commenced in March, 2025.

Considering the material on record and extent of complicity of the petitioners in the alleged offence, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioners **(1) Surojit Banik @ Pompom** and **(2) Papai Pandit @ Bapai Pandit** be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to provision under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. The petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within two weeks from date.

The petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer of the case once a week till submission of charge sheet.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
