The petitioners seek parity with the co-accused who have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court earlier.

Learned counsel for the State does not oppose the said fact.

In view of the fact that the petitioners are similarly circumstanced with the co-accused who have been granted anticipatory bail, they deserve the same benefit.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioners namely Alluddin Miah and Moslem Mia be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to

the conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. The petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within two weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail is thus disposed of.
