1. The present writ petition has been filed, inter alia, praying for a direction upon the respondents to issue land loser certificate in favour of the petitioner.
2. The petitioner claims to be the daughter-in-law of one Monoranjana Roy Sarkar (since deceased). According to the petitioner, the said Manoranjan Roy Sarkar (since deceased) had donated a portion/ parcel of land in Dag No. 784 Khatian No. 113, Mouza Tamaguri, district-Coochbehar, measuring about 13 satak to Tamaguri Junior High School. According to the petitioner, the School was constructed to the plot of land which was donated by the father-in-law of the petitioner.
3. The petitioner would submit that the petitioner at present has no source of income. The petitioner is unemployed and as such prays for issuance of a land loser certificate.

4. Having heard the learned advocates appearing for the respective parties, though the petitioner prays for issuance of land loser certificate, however from the case made out by the petitioner, I do not find the petitioner to be a land loser. As such there is no scope to allow the present writ petition.
5. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed without any order as to costs.
