- 1.** Written instructions by the petitioner be kept with the record.
- 2.** Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner after having been convicted has already undergone the sentence about it. Learned counsel submits that in the circumstances, he does not want to press the present petition and the petition may be disposed of as having been infructuous.
