1. The writ petition relates to a tender floated by Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata vide N.I.T. No. Tfc/G-6258/Tender/2024/01 dated 12th August, 2024.
2. Learned Senior Counsel representing the Port submits, upon instruction that, there was only one bidder and as the said bidder did not provide the required bid security, the bid was considered non responsive and rejected by the competent authority.
