The Court :- We have heard learned Counsel for both the parties.

The appellant seeks leave to withdraw this appeal with liberty to approach the respondent under the Direct Tax Vivad-se-Vishwas Scheme, 2024. One more prayer is made by the learned advocate for the appellant that in case the appellant is unsuccessful to resolve the matter under the settlement scheme, the appellant may be given liberty to restore this appeal and contest the same on merits.
