the parties. When the matter is called, the learned Advocate appearing for
the plaintiff has handed over a communication dated 7th February, 2025
sent by the plaintiff to the advocate on record of the plaintiff intimating that
the dispute between the parties have been settled amicably as the

defendant has issued a demand draft being No.636840 dated 6th February 2025 drawn on ICICI Bank, R.N. Mukherjee Road Branch in favour of plaintiff's company being the full and final settlement amounting to Rs.9,55,700/- by the defendant.
