1. Learned advocate for the plaintiff and learned advocate for the defendant no. 1 and learned advocate for the defendant no. 2 and the learned Receiver are present.
2. Leave is granted to the plaintiff to rectify the spelling in the cause title of proforma defendant no. 2.
3. It is submitted by the learned advocates that the parties have settled their disputes and have filed the terms of settlement.
4. Upon perusing the terms of the settlement entered into between the plaintiff and defendant no. 1 and defendant no. 2, this Court is of the

view that the suit should be disposed of in accordance with the terms of settlement.
