1. This is an application for extension of the mandate of the learned Arbitrator.
2. Both parties submit that the mandate of the learned Arbitrator is required to be extended. The mandate of the learned Arbitrator has expired on May 17, 2025.

4. Considering the progress made in the proceedings, this Court is of the view that the mandate of the learned Arbitrator should be extended.
