1. This is an application for extension of the mandate of the learned arbitrator.
2. Both the parties submit that the mandate of the learned arbitrator should be extended. Mandate of the learned arbitrator is going to expire on November 7, 2025. The proceedings are at the stage of argument. Both parties submitted before the learned arbitrator that they would take steps for extension of the mandate. Accordingly, the petitioner has filed this application.
3. None appears on behalf of the respondents, despite service.
