The Court: Mr. Nirmalya Dasgupta, learned Counsel, is appearing for the petitioner.

The petitioner has filed the present application for grant of Letters of Administration in respect of the estate of deceased, namely, Nisha Banka.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the deceased died on 15th December, 2020 leaving behind her husband, namely, Shashank Banka, married daughter, namely, Diksha Goel and one son, namely, Rishabh Banka. The petitioner before this Court is the husband of the deceased. Both the legal heirs have filed their affidavit of consent stating that they have no objection for grant of Letters of Administration of the estate of the deceased, namely, Nisha Banka to the petitioner.
