Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the W.P.(C) No.5616 of 2018 stood dismissed due to non-appearance of the petitioner's counsel. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that subsequently in the year 2022, the erstwhile counsel for the petitioner was designated as Assistant Solicitor General of India and represented the Union of India and its departments in various matter before this Hon'ble Court. It is next submitted that the dismissal of the said W.P(C) No.5616 of 2018 for non-appearance of the petitioner was neither deliberate nor intentional. It is also submitted that the petitioner has very good grounds to agitate in the said W.P(C) No.5616 of 2018 and unless the same is restored to its original file, the petitioner will be highly prejudiced. Hence, it is submitted that the

W.P(C) No.5616 of 2018 be restored to its original file.

Learned counsel for the opposite party has not raised any serious objection.

Considering the aforesaid submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, W.P(C) No.5616 of 2018 is directed to be restored to its original file at the same at which it was before its dismissal.

Registry is directed to list W.P(C) No.5616 of 2018 before the concerned Bench after two weeks.

This Civil Miscellaneous Petition is disposed of accordingly.
