03. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. This CONTC arises out of the order dated 22.11.2023 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.8086 of 2023.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Party/ Contemnor.
4. On instructions learned Counsel for the Opposite Party/Contemnor, at the outset, submits that the order passed by this Court dated 22.11.2023 in W.P.(C) No.8086 of 2023 as has been complied with in the meantime vide



order dated 08.01.2024 passed by the Under Secretary (Regn), East Coast Railway, Bhubaneswar. In view of the same, the learned counsel for the Opposite Party files an affidavit in Court today, which is taken on record. The relevant paragraph of the said order is quoted hereunder:

"with reference to the letter on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that you may take a decision following due provisions laid down in bye-laws of the society to redress the anomalies relating to the Society "All India OBC Railway Employees Association, Bhubaneswar."

5. In the above state of affair, this Court finds that nothing survives in this CONTC to be adjudicated by this Court any further.
6. The CONTC is, accordingly, disposed of being dropped.
