1] Heard learned counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the respondent-State.

2] The applicant is apprehending arrest in connection with Crime No.344 of 2023, registered with Akkalkuwa Police Station, District Nandurbar, for the offences punishable under Section 409, 420 r/w. 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3] The learned counsel for the applicant submits that this Court, by order dated 10.01.2025, has granted interim protection in favour of the applicant for the reasons stated in the said order. In terms of the said order, the applicant has attended the concerned police station and has co-operated with the investigation.

4] Considering that in terms of order dated 10.01.2025, the applicant has attended the concerned police station and has co-operated with the investigation, so also, considering that this Court by order dated 01.03.2024 in ABA No.1483/2024 has granted anticipatory bail in favour of Sarpanch, the interim protection granted by this Court by order dated 10.01.2025 stands confirmed, in the following terms :

i] The applicant shall attend the concerned police station as and when required by the Investigating Officer.

ii] The applicant shall not tamper with the evidence of the prosecution in any manner. He shall not influence the informant, witnesses and other persons concerned with the case.

iii] The applicant shall co-operate with the investigation and also in the proceedings before the trial Court.

5] In the event, the applicant violates any of the conditions specified in this order, it shall be liable to be cancelled.

6] It is also clarified that the observations made in this order are limited to the disposal of the present anticipatory bail application and the trial Court shall proceed further in the matter without being influenced by the observations made hereinabove.

7] The application stands disposed of.
