- 2 This application is for condonation of delay, setting aside abatement and permission to bring the legal representative of deceased sole appellant on record.
- 3 Perused the application. There is delay of 618 days caused in bringing the legal representative of deceased sole appellant on record.
- 4 Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
- 5 The learned AGP strongly opposed the application.
- 6 Considering the period of delay and the reasons stated in the application, the application deserves to be allowed as the delay is not

caused deliberately and intentionally. Hence, the delay is condoned. Abatement is set aside. Permission is granted to bring the legal representatives of deceased sole appellant on record.
