PER COURT :-

1. Perused the application.
2. Heard learned counsel for the applicant. It is his submission that the petition was dismissed for non removal of office objection by order of Registrar (Judicial) dated 11/11/2024. He further makes statement that notice was not issued to respondents. He, therefore, seeks dispensation of the notice to the respondents.
3. In view of the fact that the petition was not issue to the respondents, notice of this application to the respondents stands dispensed with.
