1. Heard both the sides.
2. Applicant is praying for condonation of delay of 48 days in preferring appeal on grounds stated in paragraph Nos.3 to 10. It is submitted that delay is unintentional. Applicant is ready to deposit the amount as directed by this Court on earlier occasion.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents/claimants opposes the application. It is submitted that unless amount is deposited, delay may not be condoned.
