COMMON ORDER :

1. These applications are for restoration of the

Writ Petitions, which were dismissed for non removal of office objections. Admittedly, no notices were issued to the Respondents in the original Petitions. Hence, notices to Respondents in these applications stand dispensed with.

2. Perusal of the applications indicate that sufficient reason has been recorded by the Applicants for condonation of delay of 79 days. Hence, applications stand allowed in terms of prayer clauses 'B' to 'D'.
