1 Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

2 This is an application for condonation of delay of 2988 days caused in filing the first appeal.

3 The learned AGP strongly opposed the application and submitted that there is no sufficient reason to condone the delay.

4 On perusal of the application, it appears that the delay has not been deliberately caused. Therefore, in the interest of justice, the delay deserves to be condoned on certain conditions.

5 For the reasons stated in the application, the delay stands condoned. The application stands allowed in the interest of justice. The appeal be registered.

6 It is made clear that in case the amount of compensation is enhanced, the appellants shall not be entitled for the amount of interest and other statutory benefits for the delayed period.
