PER COURT :-

1. As per the directions of this Court, the learned advocate for the applicants filed on record the paper publication of "Daily Chatinya Lok" being published in Madhya Pradesh, by which the notices are served upon respondent Nos. 1 and 2.

2. Heard learned advocate for the applicants in both the applications. He pointed out that the delay of 228 days caused filing the first appeals is not intentional or deliberate.
