None appears for respondent no. 3, who is the contesting party, though applicants pray condonation of delay of 3734 days.

2. The learned A.G.P. opposes the application.
3. The contesting party has not controverted the averments in the applications soliciting condonation of delay. There are no *mala fides* on the part of the applicants in preferring the appeals belatedly. The delay needs to be condoned on certain condition.
4. The delay stands condoned on condition that the applicants shall not be entitled to claim interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period.
