1. Heard Mr. Patekar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. V.S. Badakh, learned AGP for respondent/State.

2. The petitioner is challenging the order dated 13.01.2022 passed by the Additional Divisional Commissioner, Nashik in Case No.RTS/Revision/41/2021.

3. The petitioner is having an alternate and equally efficacious remedy against the order passed by the Additional Commissioner, Nagpur, to file a revision before the State Government and this issue is already considered by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the matter **Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. State of Maharashtra and Others** reported in **2015 AIR SCW 6277** decided on 06.11.2015.

4. In view thereof, the writ petition is disposed of, as not maintainable. No order as to costs.

5. The petitioner may file revision before the State Government within a period of six weeks from today. Delay in prosecuting the present writ petition be taken into consideration while considering the application for condonation of delay.

6. After filing of the revision, the state government to decide the same within a period of six months from today.

7. Interim relief which was already granted, shall continue till the state government decide the revision on its own merits.
