1] Heard learned counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the respondent-State.

2] The applicant is apprehending arrest in connection with Crime No.0007/2025, registered at Selu Police Station, Taluka Selu, District Parbhani, for the offences punishable under Sections 471, 468, 465, 420 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

3] This court by order dated 28.03.2025 granted interim protection to the applicant considering that the co-accused, who is directly involved has been granted anticipatory bail by order dated 13.09.2025, passed in ABA/233/2025.

4] Considering that the role of the present applicant is similarly placed to that of co-accused in ABA/233/2025, the interim protection granted earlier to the present applicant can be confirmed.

5] In view of the above, the interim protection granted by order dated 28.03.2025 stands confirmed, on the following terms:

i] The applicant shall attend the police station as and when required by the Investigating Officer.

ii] The applicant shall not tamper with the evidence of the prosecution in any manner. He shall not influence the informant, witnesses and other persons concerned with the case.

iii] The applicant shall co-operate with the investigation and also in the proceedings before the trial Court.

6] In the event, the applicant violates any of the conditions specified in this order, it shall be liable to be cancelled.

7] It is also clarified that the observations made in this order are limited to the disposal of the present

anticipatory bail application and the trial Court shall proceed further in the matter without being influenced by the observations made hereinabove.

8] The application stands disposed of.
