. This is the Application for condonation of 1828 days delay in preferring the First Appeal against the Judgment and Award dated 15.12.2014 passed by the learned Reference Court in LAR No.332 of 2003.

2. Heard the learned Advocate for the Applicant. He submits that sufficient reasons are shown in the Application, which prevented the Applicant from approaching the Court within the stipulated time. He submits that the Application be allowed.
