PER COURT :

1. Heard rival submissions.
2. The applicants are seeking permission to bring themselves on record, being the legal representatives of sole appellant – Padminibai Laxuman Gavane, who admittedly died on 04.08.2021, by condoning the delay of 303 days. Though the application is opposed by the learned Counsel for acquiring body, but considering the right to sue, it stands allowed in terms of prayer clauses 'B', 'C' and 'D', subject to cost of Rs.500/- to be paid to the Registry of this Court for utilization

of High Court Dispensary, Bench at Aurangabad. It is made clear that the applicants shall not claim any interest and statutory benefits on the enhanced amount of compensation, if granted, for the aforesaid period of delay.

3. The application is accordingly disposed of.
4. Necessary amendment be carried out within stipulated period.
5. Stand over to 13.03.2025.
