. Learned APP submits that nonailable warrant has been issued by the trial Court against applicants on account of their failure to remain present. The conduct of applicants clearly indicates that they are not abiding by the terms and conditions of bail and are not co-operating with trial Court proceedings. Under such circumstance, we do not want to exercise our powers under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in favour of persons who are not abiding by the law. Accordingly, Criminal Application stands rejected.
