1. Heard learned Counsel for the respective parties.
2. By way of this petition, the petitioner challenges the order dated 19.01.2019 in File No.2018/Bhusampadan/Kalam-28/A/CR-34 passed by the learned Sub – Divisional Officer and Land Acquisition Officer, Bhoom.
3. Learned A.G.P. and learned Counsel for the respective respondents raise a preliminary objection regarding the maintainability of the present petition on the ground that, since the reference has been rejected, the petitioner has an alternate and efficacious remedy of filing a reference under Section 28-A(3) of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.
4. In view thereof, the present petition stands disposed of as not

maintainable.

5. The petitioner is at liberty to file a reference before the competent authority.

6. The competent authority shall take into consideration the time spent by the petitioner in prosecuting the present petition while considering the application for condonation of delay.
